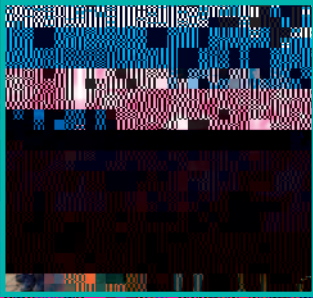

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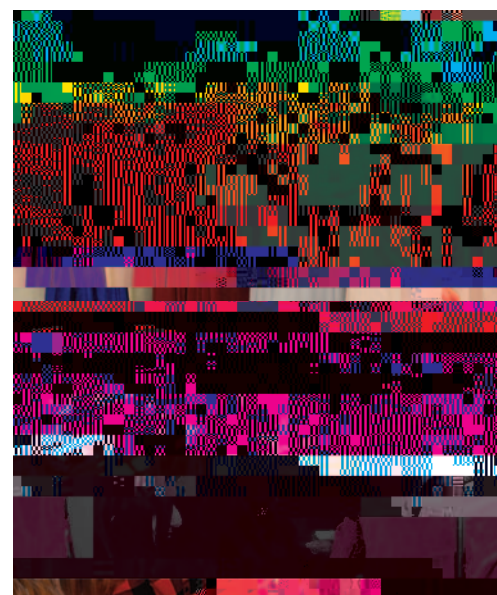

On 10th and 11th July 2018, Ofsted inspectors visited the school. The school was graded as Good.

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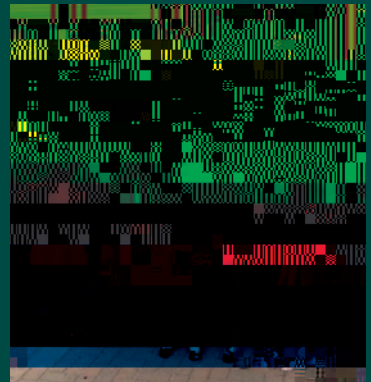
# Good

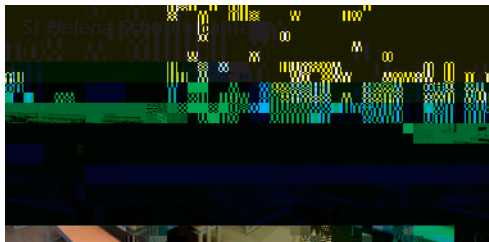

Children with attachment issues or trauma in their lives will be supported at a new nurture provision.

Holland Park Primary School has opened a dedicated unit to offer extra support to pupils with behaviour, mental health or wellbeing issues.

Six pupils will spend their mornings in the provision, which has been set up with a homely feel, including a dining area, kitchen and sofa area.

A pupil behaviour and wellbeing lead has been appointed to oversee the project and four members of staff have undertaken behaviour management training.

Headteacher Matt Moseley said: “We are

trying to really develop the pastoral support we offer to our pupils and families.

“We have been travelling around the county looking at other provisions, taking note of what is working and what is not working so well. This is a big piece of work.

“Pupils will take part in activities which will give them an opportunity to learn key skills, such as co-operation, how to regulate their emotions, building their self-esteem, teamwork, mindfulness and meditation. They will go to the shops to buy ingredients and cook for their teachers at a tea party.”

Pupils, who will spend half the day in their mainstream class, will be reintegrated full-time after a term within the provision.

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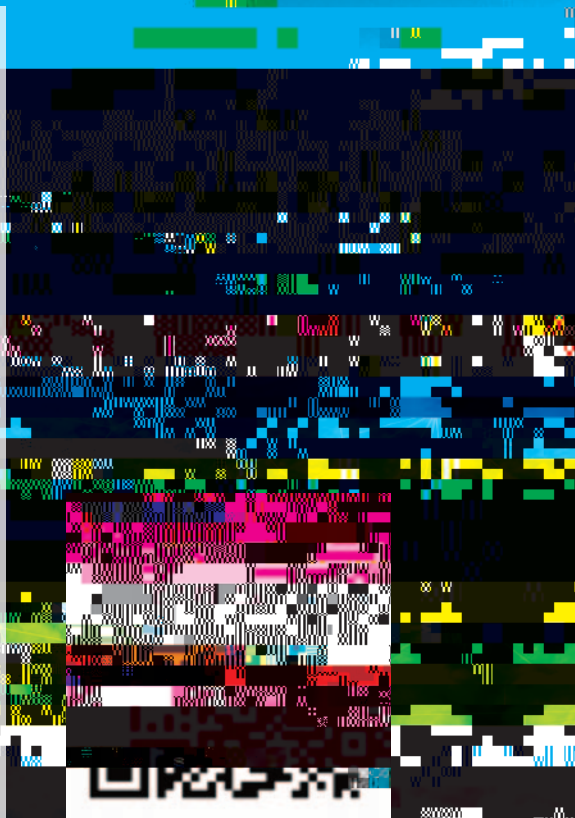

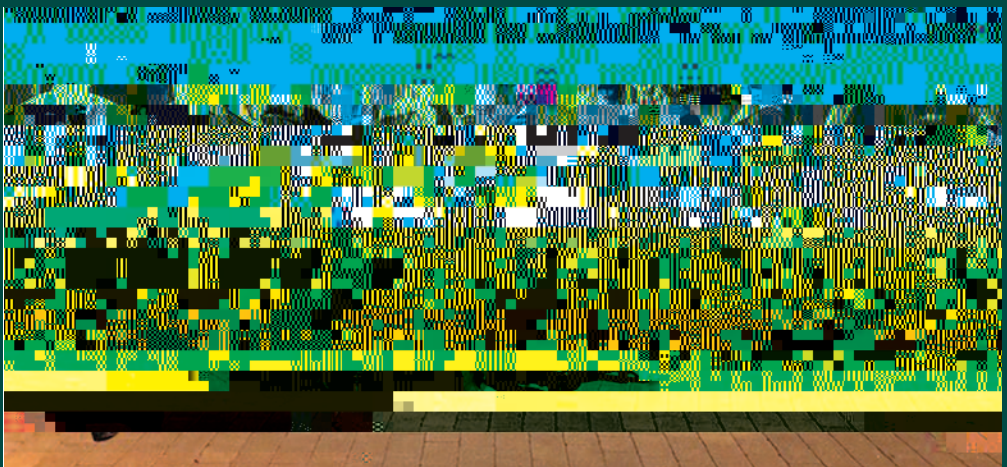

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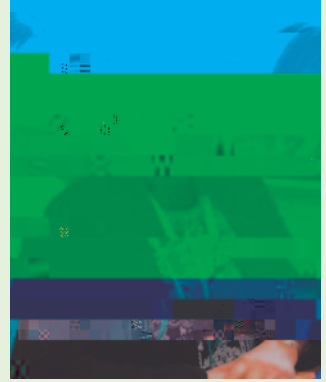
